

IT'S HERE!!!

Deckerville Community Hospital very recently received a new BiPAP ventilator. The BiPAP ventilator non-invasively helps breathing by delivering mechanically assisted breaths by means of a face mask rather than an artificial airway like an endotracheal tube.

Noninvasive positive pressure ventilation (NPPV) is an effective method of treating patients with COPD and other respiratory distress including congestive heart failure.



When NPPV is the appropriate method of

treatment; the need for endotracheal intubation; and the risks related with this, such as ventilator associated pneumonia, trauma to the airway, and disruption of swallowing and speech, may be eliminated. Aside from avoiding these unfavorable effects, patient comfort is a huge benefit.

"The quality of care we offer is raised when we upgrade our emergency equipment", said Chief of Staff, Bassam Afaneh MD. "The BiPAP is an important way to help treat respiratory problems without having to intubate the patient".

Deckerville Hospital strives to provide care close to home for our patients. The NPPV helps us to accomplish this by reducing the need for possible transfer to another facility. When transfer is necessary, NPPV can be used to buy time until advanced care is available.
